

- (ii) To preserve the social organization, mode of subsistence and cultural identity of the Jarawa community;
- (iii) To provide medical help to the Jarawas to reduce mortality and morbidity in case of their sudden affliction with diseases which their systems are unaccustomed to;

(iv) To conserve the ecology and environment of the Jarawa Reserve Territory and strengthen support systems in order to enable the Jarawas pursue their traditional modes of subsistence and way of life; and

(v) To sensitize settler communities around the Jarawas habitat and personnel working for the protection and preservation of the Jarawas about the need to preserve their unique culture and life styles.”

e) That the Hon'ble Single Bench has also failed in appreciating the danger likely to be posed to the Primitive tribe "Jarawas" if the Tourist Resort under construction at Colinpur by M/s Barefoot Ins & Leisure Pvt. Ltd. comes up and entertains domestic as well as foreign tourists with all pomp and show including attractive illumination, western music and alcohol, as being in the close vicinity of the thick Jarawa habitat the members of the primitive tribe "Jarawa" will obviously get attracted to all such designs of the modern world and it will be almost impossible for the department of Tribal Welfare, Andaman Aadim Janjati Vikas Samiti and Police to avoid interaction by and between the members of the primitive tribe and the non tribal, modern tourists population coming to the said Resort of M/s Barefoot Inns & Leisure Pvt. Ltd.

f) That such indulgence/interaction by and between the Jarawa and the tourists at the Resort of M/s Barefoot Inns & Leisure Pvt. Ltd. will, beyond doubt, lead to the Jarawas picking up packaged fast food, beverages as well as alcohol available therein, which is absolutely detrimental and hazardous to their immune system as well as their tribal culture and values.

g) That there are ample evidence world over including one of another small primitive tribe namely "Andamanese" in Andaman & Nicobar Islands that due to such process of interaction and assimilation of the small primitive tribes with the non tribal outside world the smaller Primitive Tribes have
