(b) The two notification as mentioned above which are proposed by the Department of Tribal Welfare may evoke huge social and political response as till now all non-tribals including permanent inhabitants, settlers and tourists are passing through the Jarawa Tribal Reserve without obligation of any tribal pass. As such the two notifications proposed by the Tribal Welfare Department may first be published as draft inviting claims and objections if any and thereafter, after examining all pros and cons final notifications may be issued. This will also give the gestation period for implementation of the same on ground tentatively by the end of the current tourist season.

Accordingly a draft minutes of the meeting held on 11-2-2008 has been prepared and placed opposite in the file for perusal and approval please.
