

6) That it is further submitted that the respondent was constructing its

Resort at Collinpur village which is within a distance of one
kilometre from the Jarawa area, which is against the provision of
the policy on Jarawa Tribe of Andaman Island formulated on the
solemn directions of the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Hon'ble
Court in W.P. (PIL) No. 048 of 1999.

- 7) That it is submitted that the notification dated 30/10/2007 has been issued for protection of Jarawa Tribe and to maintain their status, culture and heritage of primitive tribes and said notification cannot be set-aside.
- 8) That it is submitted that the notification dated 30/10/2007 was issued to protect the Jarawa tribes from harmful effects of exposure and contact with the out side world which the Jarawa tribe is not accustomed to.
  - 9) That it is submitted that the notification dated 30/10/2007 was issued to preserve the social organization, mode of substance and cultural identity of Jarawa community and also to reduce mortality and morbidity in case of there sudden affliction with diseases which the Jarawa community is not accustomed to.
