Madam,

This is in continuation of our letter No. SP(D)/A/2008/9334 dated 20<sup>th</sup> November, 2008 (copy enclosed). It must be stated that on 23<sup>rd</sup> November at around 1400 hrs., an information was received by DySP., Middle Andaman that one of the Jarawa tribal who was involved in the incident that led to the registration of cases vide Cr. No. 85/08 dated 20/11/'08 U/s 147/148/149/302/324/325/396 IPC and Cr. No. 86/08 dated 20/11/'08 U/s 7/8 PAT Regulation, 1956 at PS., Kadamtala was missing from that fateful day. DySP, Middle Andaman along with other police personnel immediately left for Kadamtala. On arrival, DySP (MA) met the AAJVS staff of Kadamtala area and learned that one male Jarawa namely 'HOTELE' was missing from the time of incident which had led to the killing of a fisherman. On 24<sup>th</sup> morning DySP (MA) along with AAJVS staff led by Anoop Mondal, Tribal Welfare Officer and Medical Officer Dr. Sandeep
