Poachers suffer rage of Primitive tribes Jarawa Group Kills one, injures three fishermen at Mahuwa Tikry "HUM LOG BHUKHA HAI: JARAWA"

Port Blair, Nov 20: A group of nearly 10 Jarawa people have killed one fisherman and injured three others yesterday, who had ventured inside their tribal reserve forest for fishing. The incident took place on Wednesday morning at Mahuwa Tikry area of Kadamtala Island, when the eight member fishermen group anchored their dinghies at

Mahuwa Tikry and were trying to cook food on a Kerosine stove.

Soon nearly eight Jarawa members came out from forest and two Jarawa tribes reached the spot in a machine dinghy. The tribal members were demanding rice and other food-stuffs from them, some of the tribal men climbed into the dinghy and were trying to take away food-stuffs.

Meanwhile, hot water kept on the stove fell on the leg of one of the Jarawa tribe, which provoked him to stab one fisherman with his arrow. The fishermen, G Erraiah aged 42 r/o fishermen colony Junglighat, with fatal injuries of arrow, died on the spot.

According to police Jarawa people also injured three other fishermen with arrows. (See... Page...02)
