

May kindly peruse notes from Para 176/N onwards. This is regarding engagement of Mr. Ashok Kumar Banerjee, Senior Counsel from Kolkata for defending the case in CAN No. 060 of 2008, CAN No. 042 of 2008 with MAT No. 016 of 2008 in W.P No. 328 of 2007- The Lt. Governor & Ors-VS- M/s. Bare Foot Inns & Leisure Pvt. Ltd as Intervener Appellant before the Division Bench of Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta, Circuit Bench at Port Blair.

In this context it may be mentioned that the above said case was scheduled to come up for hearing in the last sitting of Division Bench of Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta, Circuit Bench at Port Blair commenced from 25.8.2008 but it could not be held. The Govt. Advocate Shri. S.K. Mondal informed that the above said case will come up for hearing in the next sitting of Division Bench of Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta, Circuit Bench at Port Blair commencing from 17th September, 2008.

Further it has been ascertained from the Deputy Secretary (Law), A&N Administration that Mr. A.K Banerjee, Senior Counsel, Kolkatta is arriving Port Blair by flight on 21st/22nd September, 2008 to appear before the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta in a case of Information & Publicity Department. If approved, we may request Shri. A.K Banerjee, Senior Counsel, Kolkatta to appear before the Division Bench of Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta, Circuit Bench at Port Blair to defend the above said case. In the meanwhile, we may also request the Govt. Advocate Shri. S.K. Mondal to get the above said case scheduled for hearing on 21st/22nd September, 2008 in the Division Bench of Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta, Circuit Bench at Port Blair, so that Shri. A.K Banerjee, Senior Counsel, Kolkatta can appear and defend the case.
