NOTIFICATION

No F.No. 1-467/2004-TW. In exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes), Regulation, 1956 (Regulation No. 3 of 1956), the Lt. Governor, A & N Islands, is pleased to declare the area upto five Km radius around the Jarawa Tribal Reserve notified vide No. 159/2004 / F. No. 1-752/2002-TW(PF) dt.15-9-2007 from the Boundary Line starting from Constance Bay in South Andaman to Lewis Inlet Bay in Middle Andaman as a Buffer Zone. Any person other than a member of an aboriginal tribe is prohibited from entering the Buffer Zone for any commercial and / or tourism activities except petty Business like Tea Shop, Pan Shop and Procery Shop etc.
