so that he can raise small gardens of banana, papaya, guava and such other plants and teach his own people how to nurture these plants. This may ultimately help to set in motion the process of transformation of a food gathering community into food producers. This may even be followed by keeping fowls as an additional food resource.

It may be interesting to know from what source the idea of training up a Jarawa ward boy first camp up -- Anthropology or Tribal Welfare?

Electoral Roll Revision

All is set to take up the gigantic task of house-to-house enumeration starting all over the islands from 13-9-2001. About 492 enumerators and 143 supervisors will be on duty for verification and enumeration work as part of the special electoral roll revision of an intensive nature.

The Election Commission of India has ordered for special revision of electoral rolls with reference to January one, 2002 as a qualifying date, official sources informed here today.

Sources further informed that the electoral roll revision, will continue upto October 12, 2001. The preparation and completion of draft roll will be done by November 23 and it will be published on November 24. Claims and objections can be filed between November 24 to December 10. Disposal of claims and objections by January nine, 2002 while the final publication of rolls will be done on January 31, 2002.
