During my visit to Baratang, Uttara and Kadamtala Area on 3rd & 4th Sept. 2000 and after meeting people of these area and discussing the following points are mentioned for your kind attention and necessary action :-

1. The complaint of the resident of the area is that the Jarawas are entering in the villages and while going back they are taking away the ration and other articles like Iron Bucket, utensils and other house hold articles. Not only this they also cut down and destroy the fruit bearing trees.
2. No immediate relief is provided to effected people as is being done in other cases of damages viz. fire accident etc. by the administration. Even the cases of 6 months old are lying pending for providing of relief with the Administration.
3. Secretary (Welfare) and Supdt. of Police of A & N Adm. visited Kadamtala few days back. It is reported by the people of the area that generally Jarawas entering in Kadamtala area from the side of Paniaka Khari (old Jetty). In Bamboo Tekry there is one check post, either this check post be shifted to the corner of land of Gopal Chintu Patra to have better check.
4. For distribution of ration etc. a Committee has been formed with Asstt. Commissioner, Mayabunder as Chairman, Tehsildar, Rgt., AE, Patwari and Pradhan Kadamtala are
