NOTE.— 1. For cadres of 2 to 13 posts, the roster is to be read from entry 1 under column Cadre Strength till the last post and then horizontally till the last entry in the horizontal row, i.e., like "L".

2. All the posts of a cadre are to be earmarked for the categories shown under column Initial Appointment. While initial filling up will be by the earmarked category, the replacement against any of the post in the cadre shall be by rotation as shown horizontally against the last post of the cadre.

3. The relevant rotation by the indicated reserved category could be skipped over if it leads to more than 50% representation of reserved category.

Data Circuits on Digital Transmission Media leased by DoT to Press subscribers

Kindly refer to this office Circular No. 4-8/92-R & C, dated the 4th December, 1992, wherein the method of allowing the concession to the Press was clarified. It has now been decided that $\frac{2}{3}$ rd concession to the Press will be worked out as under in respect of data circuits provided by DoT to the Press.

Normal rental as per prescribed tariff will be worked out as applicable for non-Press subscribers.

Rental payable by the Press will then be fixed at $\frac{1}{3}$ rd of minimum or maximum or of any sum in between as per the formula, whichever is higher as per the illustration given in the Annexure enclosed.

ANNEXURE

FOR PRESS SUBSCRIBERS
(as per 64 Kbps cct. tariff)

Example (1):

	Rs.
(i) For chargeable distance 250 kms.	
(ii) Normal Rental as applicable to non-Press subscriber 1125 x 250 kms.	= 2,81,250
(iii) Limited to Minimum limit (at normal rental)	= 3,75,000
(iv) Less $\frac{2}{3}$ rd concession admissible to the Press	= 2,50,000
(v) Rental payable by Press subscriber	= 93,750 (A)
(vi) Rental payable by Press at $\frac{1}{3}$ rd of minimum of (iii) above	= 1,25,000 (B)
Since (B) is higher, the rentals to be recovered from the Press subscriber would be	= 1,25,000

Example (2):

(i) For chargeable distance 400 kms.	
(ii) Normal Rental 1125 x 400 kms. (which is higher than the minimum limit, i.e., 3.75 lakhs)	= 4,50,000
