NOTE 2.—The Administrative Ministries should wait for a fortnight for the views of the Commissioner on such proposal, for examination in the light of such view, if any.

6. Dereservation in Central Secretariat Services

In respect of certain decentralised cadres in the Central Secretariat Services, the recruitment/promotion is made by the CS Division of the Department of Personnel and Training through the examinations conducted by the UPSC/SSC. Dereservation of reserved vacancies in these cases will be made as follows:—

- (a) The various cadre controlling authorities will maintain the 40 point roster and at the time of recruitment, they will furnish the Dept. of Per. and Trg. with the details of vacancies both unreserved and reserved including those carried forward, in the Pro forma (Appendix 17) with the required certificates, through the Liaison Officers concerned.
- (b) The vacancies will be consolidated by the CS Division and communicated to the UPSC or SSC for recruitment.
- (c) On receipt of recommendation from the UPSC/SSC, the CS Division will make necessary proposal for dereservation to the SCT Division taking into account the reserved vacancies (including those carried forward) and the actual availability of SC/ST candidates recommended by the UPSC/SSC.
- (d) On receipt of clearance from SCT Division, the CS Division will allocate the candidates to various cadres.
