OFFICE MEMORANDUM

The Reservation roster - Post based - Implementation of the Supreme Court Judgement in the case of R.K. Sabharwal Vs. State of Punjab.

The undersigned is directed to say that under the existing instructions, vacancy-based rosters have been prescribed in o.der to implement Government's policy relating to reservation of for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes the Other Backward Classes. The application reservation on the basis of these rosters was called into question before Courts. The Constitution Bench of the Supreme Court, in the case of R.K. Sabharwal Vs. State of Punjab as well as J.C. Mallick Vs. Ministry of Railways has held that the reservation of jobs for the backward classes SC/ST/OBC should apply to posts and not to vacancies. The Court further held that the vacancy based rosters can operate only till such time as the representation of persons belonging to the reserved categories, in a cadre, reaches the prescribed percentages of reservation. Thereafter, the rosters cannot operate and vacancies released by retirement, resignation, presenting, atc. Thereafter, Thereafter, the rosters cannot operate and vacancies released by retirement, resignation, promotion etc. of the persons belonging to the general and the reserved categories are to be filled by appointment of persons from the respective category so that the prescribed percentage of reservation is maintained.

The Court also held that persons belonging to the reserved categories, who are appointed on the basis of merit -- and not on account of reservation -- are not to be counted towards the quota meant for reservation.

3. With a view to bringing the policy of reservation in life with the law laid down by the supreme Court, it has been decided that the existing 200-point, 40-point and 120-point vacancy-based rosters shall be replaced by post-based rosters. All proceeds the consequence of the co Ministries/Department: and concerned Authorities are requested to prepare the respective rosters based on the principles elaborated in the Explanatory Notes the principles elaborated in the Explanatory Notes given in Annexore-1 to this O.N. and illustrated in the Model Rosters annexed to this O.M. as Annexore-II, III and IV. Similarly, the concerned authorities may prepare rosters to replace the existing 100-point rosters in respect of local recruitment to Group C & D pests on the basis of the same principles. same principles.
