

**Tribal sub Plan review meeting held in the Conference Hall of the District Hospital, Car Nicobar on 25.10.99 at 4.15 PM.**

The meeting was presided over by Shri Chandra Bhushan Kumar, DC (N) and it was attended by the following: -

Moving from the customary way of having Tribal Sub Plan review meeting, for the first time we had departmental wise TSP review meeting in the offices of the concerned Sector.

The Chairman took the business of the day and outlined the importance of having such a meaningful meetings, and asked Medical Supdt. if he has received any progress report from DHS, P/B for the meeting, he, replied in negative. This is even after several requests to this effect that the DC (N) is the Chairman of ITDP and review of TSP's are being carried out by him in every quarter at Car Nicobar and the MS, C/N could not furnish the progress report to us other than what is done at Car Nicobar. The Directorate may invariably furnish copies of the progress report on the schemes/works under TSP to the Project Officer, ITDP on every month and a copy of it may also be endorsed to the Medical Supdt., Car Nicobar so, that he may attend the TSP review meetings/Co-ordination meetings at Car Nicobar in a more meaningful manner.

Civil Hospital, Car Nicobar is running without a regular Medical Superintendent, for more than one and half years.

Establishment of Sub Centers at Enam and Englee. MS, C/ N does not have any information about its present status, although the Civil Hospital, C/N has been designated as District Hospital. AC, Nancowry and AC, C/Bay may confirm the present position the Sub Centres proposed to be setup in the current financial year.

The new Kitchen block constructed in the District Hospital, Car Nicobar has not yet been made functional. The new mortuary is functional.

Construction of quarters at Car Nicobar, land has been identified by the deptt, A.P.W.D may look into, its other aspects and take necessary action on priority.

The Registration Certificate of beneficiaries under Planned Family by 2000 AD received at Civil Hospital, Car Nicobar is incomplete i.e name of village to which the beneficiaries actually belongs to, has not been indicated. In this connection the Education Officer, Car Nicobar may provide copy of the list of beneficiaries sent to the DHS, Port Blair by the various Institutional heads to the Medical Superintendent, Car Nicobar as the M.S, C/Niic is finding it difficult in the distribution of the same.

EE, CD, APWD, Car Nicobar may complete the Arong, sub Center work on priority and hand over it at the earliest possible.

It has been come to know that there was no T.B drugs for one month, knowing the fact that, how important is its un-interrupted consumption to the patients. In this connection MS, C/N may review the stock position of medicines on monthly basis and take up the matter with the concern authorities.
