Sub: Proposal regarding details of schemes/projects proposed to be implemented under the Special Central Assistance under Annual Tribal Sub-Plan, 1999-2000.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the Tribal Sub Plan comprises UT flow of funds and Special Central Assistance provided by the GOI, Ministry of SJ&E as supplement. The formulation of UT plan for 1999-2000 has not been taken up, so is the case with the Annual Tribal Sub-Plan for 1999-2000 as it is integral part of UT plan. The funds required for implementation of the schemes under UT flow of funds would have been provided under the BE for 1999-2000 so that the continuing schemes could be implemented pending formulation of Tribal Sub-Plan, 1999-2000. It may be recalled here that the GOI, Ministry of Finance has restricted the overall budget for UT plan to the last year's UT Plan allocation, i.e., 350 crore. Accordingly, you may go ahead with the implementation of continuing schemes under UT flow of funds pending formulation Tribal Sub-Plan 1999-2000.

So far as the fund under Special Central Assistance is concerned the administration is required to submit utilization report both physical and financial to the GOI Ministry of SJ&E followed by the details of the schemes / projects for release of the fund for the current financial year 1999-2000. In this connection a reference is invited to this office letter No. 1-474/99-TW/237 dated 31st March 1999 requesting you to furnish the utilization report to this office immediately.

Further it is pointed out that the Five Year Programmes in respect of Special Central Assistance have been included under the Tribal Sub-Plan for the Ninth Five Year Plan. So the details of the schemes/projects to be implemented during the current financial year could be worked out on the basis of the programmes already included in the TSP for the Ninth Five Year Period.
