

EDUCATION

Construction of Primary School at Tapoingming, Car Nicobar is not justified for the present in view of the fact that a Middle School is functioning at a walkable distance of 1 Km. i.e at Chukchucha. Similarly Primary School at Pasa, Car Nicobar is again a wastage of recurring and non-recurring expenditure as there is no such village named "Pasa". However, there is some houses which are inhabited by the people of Jayanthi and Mus Villages and a Primary School is already functioning at Tee Top which is just at a Kilometre distance.

Construction of Campus fencing at SSS Lapathy,Car Nicobar. It was stressed by Haji Ebrahim Ali Hussain, Vice Chief Captain & Shri J.B.Daniel, Secretary Tribal Council that the good play grounds of the School is being damaged by the cattle and pigs and in order to protect it from the menace of cattle etc. there is urgent need of construction of an economical and fool proof RCC compound walling with atleast a 2 feet RCC casting and then Hollow Blocks. (Action by: Director of Education, Port Blair)

E.O Car Nicobar may prepare proposals for renovation for existing Pre-Primary Schools at Head quarter. EE, CD, Car Nicobar may prepare estimates for the renovation of SSS, Lapathy. Action by 31.3.2000. Education Officer, may also prepare proposals for the renovation works. He may also pursue the sanction of PS building at Ethoii at Katchai.

FOREST

Joint Forest Management suggested in the meeting held on 21.10.99 did not materialise. Since, Nicobars is a tribal reserve area and unless people participation is ensured by the above mechanism it would be futile exercise to formulate schemes for implementation.
