Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to this Administration's letter of even number dated 2nd July, 1996 on the subject cited above.

In this connection, it may be pointed out that in terms of your D.O letter No.11017/1/95-SCH.CELL dated 28/2/96, the scheme of award of post matric scholarships to the ST candidate for Commercial Pilot Licence Course was adequately publicised in the tribal areas. This Administration has received application plain papers from the ST candidates for undergoing C.P.L. Course. The prescribed application forms are not available with this Administration. Besides, the eligibility criteria laid down for selecting the candidates is also not available in this Administration. So this Administration is unable to select any candidate and recommend to the Ministry of Welfare for award of scholarships for want of prescribed application form and eligibility criteria.

You are, therefore, requested to kindly look into the matter and furnish the eligibility criteria alongwith application form for C.P.L Course to this Administration.
