Subject : Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post Matric Scholarship to students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes - Clarification regarding Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL) course included in Group 'B' with reference to regulations governing the scheme w.e.f. 1.7.1989.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the above subject and to say that this Ministry has recently reviewed the coverage under the Commercial Pilot Licence course (CPL) included in Group 'B' of the regulations governing the said scheme. In this regard this Ministry's wireless message No. 11017/2/91-Sch.Cell, dated 20.12.1991 and the subsequent reminders may be referred to. The information ascertained from the State Governments/UT Administrations receiving central assistance under the scheme, indicates that not more than two or three candidates were awarded the scholarship etc. under the scheme. Keeping in view the extent of utilisation and the financial aspects of the C.P.L. course, it has been decided that beginning from the financial year 1992-93 i.e. with effect from 1.4.1992, 15 (fifteen) awards combined for all concerned State Governments and Union Territory Administrations will be provided for every financial year towards the Commercial Pilot License Course. Each concerned State Government/ Union Territory Administration, on receiving applications for this course from the prospective candidates, will initially scrutinise them at the earliest for determining their eligibility under the scheme and thereafter, intimate to this Ministry the number of such eligible applicants for the CPL course during a financial year. The application forms are, however, not required to be sent to this Ministry. The Ministry on receipt of such information from the concerned State Governments/UT Administrations, will immediately entertain this information and immediately give clearance to the concerned State/UT on first come first served basis, till such time 15 awards have been accounted for in the Ministry's records for a financial year. The Ministry will keep on entertaining the receipt of above mentioned information
