


from the States/UTs, throughout the year. In case the total number has exceeded 15, the Ministry will take a review of the excess applicants. It is also clarified that the flight charge being a compulsory fees are to be paid under the scheme, apart from the maintenance allowance.

2. It is requested that the concerned State Govts./ UT Admns. should give due publicity to the CPL course so that 15 earmarked awards for this course are fully utilised. It is also clarified, that the regulations governing the award of scholarships under the scheme, as applicable with effect from 1.7.1989 remain valid and unchanged.
