This is regarding implementation of excise policy in tribal areas. The National Commissions for SCs and STs has been entrusted to monitor and evaluate all policies and programs affecting the welfare of SCs and STs. The Govt. of India has decided this action. We send a detailed note on the excise policy in this U.T. with reference to its extension and working in the tribal areas.

In this connection it may be mentioned that no liquor shop is opened in the tribal areas of Andhra Pradesh. The scheduled tribes of these islands do not brew any traditional liquor for their consumption. However, one of them has liquor from colonial times which is their traditional drink. The excise policy laid down by the Govt. is fully implemented in this U.T. The present position in the tribal areas is not known to the Deptt. Its approval we may ascertain the required information from the D.S.C. (Excise), Andhra P. Dr (Andhra) and S.D.M.
