The Govt. of India, Ministry of Welfare vide PVC has sent a copy of guidelines relating to Excise Policy in tribal areas in response to this Admin's Signal at page 3/c. The Govt has further desired this Admin. to intimate the present position regarding implementation of the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Welfare.

In this connection, it may be mentioned that a regulation called "A for Islands - (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) regulation, 1956 is in force in this U/T to safeguard the interest of the tribals. The sale of distilled liquor (Indian made foreign liquor) is not allowed in the tribal areas. However, the tribals are allowed to tap toddy their traditional drink from the coconut trees.
