(1) PUC is the letter dated 15/05/2006 of Assistant Secretary (Edn.), A & N Administration addressed to Assistant Secretary (Personal), A & N Administration enclosing therewith copies of representation with enclosures from Jharkhand Mukti Morcha and Ranchi Association received from Prime Minister's office regarding memorandum / representation submitted to the Prime Minister during his visit to A&N Islands on 03-05, January 2006. The Assistant Secretary (Education) has forwarded the copies of the above letter alongwith the representation to this department for necessary action. The representation submitted to Prime Minister by the Ranchi Association and Jharkhand Mukti Morcha, Port Blair relates to the following four issues:

1. implement the Supreme Court Order 2005, SCCI.com 97 date of judgment 11/02/05 in Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
2. include the Chotanagpur's tribes in the tribal list of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands
3. stop the eviction of Chotanagpur's tribals encroacher in the forest land.
4. consider the migrant tribal children against the unutilized seats in the technical and non technical high education in mainland till the Chotanagpur's tribals are included in the tribal list of A&N Islands.

(2) The 1st and 2nd issues concern Tribal Welfare Department, while the 3rd issue pertain to Forest Department, Deputy Commissioner of the District and 4th issue pertain to Education Section of the Administration.

(3) In the first instance, we may request Assistant Secretary (Perl), A&N Administration to call for the reports from the concerned authorities, if approved. Accordingly a U.O note is placed in the file for perusal and approval please.
