Further, Ministry of Home Affairs O.M. No. 42/21/49-NGS, dated 28.01.1952 has been also clarifying in Para 9 of said O.M. that "the instructions apply *mutatis mutandis* to all Union Territories (i.e. Part C States) as well. Such Union Territories (Part C States) should also therefore, observe this instructions and submit their returns to the Ministry of Home affairs". Moreover, Ministry of Home affairs addressed a letter to the Chief Commissioner of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Port Blair during on 1st February 1960 in response of A & N Admn.'s letter No. 45-142/59-Adm. Dated 31.08.1959 clarifying the doubt of the A & N Admn. regarding Orders issued by the Govt. of India for applicability of the rules and Orders governing by the Central Govt. Servants, to the Govt. Servants of A & N Admn. In this regards the M.H.A. clarified that "there is no Special Orders in this connection^{of} A & N Admn. All Orders of the Govt. of India, unless otherwise stated, are applicable to the employees of the A & N Administration as they are also Central Govt. Servant".

Therefore, under the A & N Admn. there is no any doubt regarding reservation Policy of the Govt of India is also applicable in Union Territories in regard to reservations for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in posts and services in same footing also applicable in A & N Administration, which Admn. is also under the control of Govt. of India.

Hence, it is request to your kindself that the necessary instructions may kindly be issued to all the Departments under your good control for compliance of various Orders & instructions issued by the Govt. of India from time to time in regard to reservations for all Scheduled Castes and Schedule Tribes in Govt. services under the A & N Union Territory Administration on the analogies of the Central Government Servants and oblige please.
