

Finance Department

23. The Finance department shall be consulted in all cases in which previous concurrence is necessary under the relevant Rules, orders and instructions.
24. When the Finance department is consulted, the views of that department shall be brought on to the permanent record of the department to which the case belongs and shall form part of the case.
25. The Finance Secretary may call for any papers from any department in which financial consideration is involved and the department to whom the request is addressed, shall supply the papers.
26. Finance department may make rules to govern financial procedure in general in all departments and to regulate the business of the Finance department and the dealings of other departments with the Finance department, with the approval of the Administrator.

Law Department

27. The Law department shall be consulted in all cases of legislation, litigation, contracts, amendment to Acts and Rules, subordinate legislation and juridical administration.
28. Proposals to initiate Regulations, Rules etc shall be treated as a case and referred to Law department along with
- (i) the need for the proposed legislation from the legal point of view;
 - (ii) the competence to promulgate the Regulation and the Rules proposed;
 - (iii) the Ministry of the Central Government concerned.
 - (iv) the consistency of the proposed measure with the provisions of the Constitution and in particular those relating to the fundamental rights.
 - (v) Financial Memorandum regarding the recurring and non-recurring expenditure, if any, from the Consolidated fund of the Union territory;
