the forest labourers could not study due to lack of schools and communication, hence encroached forest lands for livelihood.

d) The administration and ruling party neleglated the area of

Chotanagpur tribals. Hancepuri village under Chainpur Panchyat, Maya Bunder tehsil, North Andaman more than 800 population is the living example of negligence, where 99% habitants are Rachis. To reach this place one has to walk more than 4 hours on barefoot during rainy season, cross 11 Hillocks and several nallas, with luggage and baggage, sheding bloods set due to full of liches. There is no road, no ferry boats, engine dengi is available at Mayabunder but one has to pay more than 900 Rs to reach this villages. There is a single teacher primary school, primary health centre and electric line but the teacher is found usually absent, in the hospital only one staff, ward boy, the electricity department is only for the name sake because no staff wants to be there. The government has setteled this village in 1961 but neither the administration nor the ruling party has taken serious efforts to improve the life condition of this villagers, Road is essential to transport agriculture products to the market and to bring goods from the market.

v) The supreme court order 2005 SCCI com 97 date of judgment 1-02-05 directed the Pondicherry Union Territory. To consider migranted SCs/STs against the reserve post/service for the SCs/STs(A Xerox copy enclosed) The Pondicherry Union Territory and Andaman & Nicobar Union Territory both are standing on the same footing, there fore the same supreme court order / judgment must be implemented in Andaman & Nicobar union territory too. This will help the Ranchi children to get some jobs in the administration.

vi) we have approached the higher authorities in the government since 1979 through Ranchi Association for the inclusion of the Chotanagpur tribals in the tribal list of Andaman & Nicobar Islands but so far no step is taken by the administration as well as by the central government.
