The recommendation of the Commission has been accepted by the Government. Therefore, the percentage of reservations for Schaduled Tribes in the new 100 point rosters, now prescribed, correspond to the actual proportion of population of Schaduled Tribes in the States and Union Territories, and not a minimum reservation of 5 per cent irrespective of the proportion of Scheduled Tribes, in the population of the State Union Territory as hitherto done.

3. There will be no change in the all-India percentages of reservations for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes as also the 100 point roster for Assam.
