- (iv) Secondly in 1984 the children of these Islanders were divided into categories for technical & Non Technical Higher Education in mainland, 50% seats for the children of Pre-42 A Settlers, 20% seats for the Children of Local S.Ts, 10% seats for the children of central government employees and the rest 20% for the children of general categories, not a single percent was for the children of Ranchi Community even unavailed tribal reserve seats were given to the children of Pre-42 & Settlers. Ranchi Tribals came Andaman before Bengali Refugee Settlers but they are deprived of settlers facilities. In 1997, the REC Seats reserved for ST's are banned for migrated S.T. Children.
- (v) Thirdly due to the Supreme Court order 7/5/02 for the eviction of Forestland the fruit bearing trees and the crops were destroyed by the Forest Department among the affected people 47% were Ranchi labourers. The children of these labourers working in jungle could not study due to lack of schools & lack of communication facilities in jungle.
- (vi) The Supreme Court order / Judgement 2005 SCCI dated 11-02-05 directed the Pondichery Union Territory to consider the migrated SCs/ STs against the reserved Post/ Serve serviced Post/ Services for SCs/ STs (Ranchi Association, A & N Islands, already submitted a Xerox copy). Andaman & Nicobar Union Territory & Pondichery territory both are standing on same footing therefore the Supreme Court order/ judgement must be implemented must be implemented in Andaman & Nicobar Union Territory too.
- (vii) Our Demands for -
- (i) Implementation of Supreme Court order/ Judgement 2005 SCCI on 97 dated 11-02-2005 Andaman & Nicobar Union Territory,
- (ii) Inclusion of Ranchi Chotanagpur tribal people in the Tribal list of Andaman & Nicobar Islands under article 16 (4) and 239.
- (iii) Admission of Chotanagpur tribal children against the unveiled reserved seats in Technical & Non Technical Higher Education reserved for scheduled tribes. The ban of admission of migrated tribes in Regional Engineering College Durgapur reserved for ST candidates should be removed.
- (iv) Stopping eviction of Chotanagpur tribal encroaches in Reserved forest land keeping in view of Para 29 of Chief Secretaries first address of both houses of parliament on 7-6-2004
