- Kindly refer to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Welfare, New Delhi's letter No. 12016/30/95-3 CD(R.Cell) dated 12th July 1995 (Xerox copy of the letter enclosed for your kind reference please) in response to our representation No. KBCA/95/03 dated 18/05/1995, requesting to recognize the Karen Community living in Andaman & Nicobar Islands as Scheduled Tribe.
- Interim relief/ Welfare measures for the upliftment of the Karen Community by way of reservation of Seats in Educational, Professional / Technical Institution and reservation in job in Andaman & Nicobar Islands prayed for till such time, the Karen of A & N Islands are declared Scheduled Tribe.
- 3. This particular Tribe numbering about 2200 have their own distinct language, culture and tradition are socially, educationally and economically backward, hence, required to be protected from immiment extinction by guaranteeing them the constitutional status as Scheduled Tribe.
