were a total of 273 scavengers employed in Port Blain Municipal Council. The Manual scavenging has since been completely abolished, these persons are now rehabilitate and re-deployed elsewhere. Considering the arguments of Director (TW) if the above 273 families comprising of members each the total population of scavengers would come to 0.4% of the total population of these islands, which would be approximately 1365 persons.

Gur earlier stand, that in these islands there has been so much intermingling and intermarriages among different castes that, it is difficult to determine who belongs to which caste still holds good has far as the question of untouchability is concerned if is not prevailing in these islands. We are not if position to indicate broad migration pattern.

As far as the question of Munda, Oraon, Kharia and Dhanka are concerned, we have already informed Ministry vide our Fax Message at F/A that they are known as Rachi in these islands. We have constituted an "Other Backward Class Commission" and these castes can get identified a OBCs when the process for identifying them are start provided they fulfill the criteria.
