A thorough Scientific study about the bearing capacity of these Islands was conducted and it was concluded that these Islands can not sustain a population of more than 3.5 Lakhs as 34% of the land is under forests cover and the remaining area which has already reached saturation can not absorb more population. The Govt of India after considering the problems directed A & N Administration to provide Islanders identify Cards so that entry of more influx people can be checked. These Cards are provided to only people of Have-Lock and Nail Islands and the matter is solved; the reasons are best known to authorities, Unless the influx is controlled the problems of Islanders will be worsening further.
