6) Power Problem:

These Islands is facing a very serious power crisis, and Minister of Power has kindly agreed to immediately install a 3 M.W. Power Generating set under public sector undertaking under PSU. This should be done on war footing otherwise the people will face a very bad situation. The Electricity Department has paid Crores of rupees in foreign currency to a Norway firm for two crank shafts. But years have passed no crank shafts has been received and three engines of 2.5 M.W. capacity is gaining rust over them in Chatham Power House and these were not shown to the Power Minister who also felt other-wise when it was brought to the knowledge and he could not visit Chatham Power House as there was no time.

After the deputation of Shri Kumara Mangalam, the Power Minister one more 2.5 M.W. Diesel Engine Developed the same defect and broke down and now the Power Supply has reached to a critical point. An expert enquiry is necessary to know the cause and to avoid such thing in future and if any one is found guilty of negligence for such heavy damages should be punished.
