- 6. Executives of the States and requested them to provide succour to the sufferers and punishment to the guilty. In this context, I would like to state that the response from the States is rather discouraging. You may agree with me that above issues are crucial and deserve special attention of the elected Governments. Unless and until, special efforts are iniaited, such atrocities go unabated. Here too, I wish you have a resourceful role to play. As a Hon'ble Chief Minister, I earnestly request you to highlight the above two issues in the ongoing winter session of the Parliament and draw the special attention of the Govt. of India emphasising the constitutional obligation with the elected Governments towards SC/ST people.
- 9 The Federation consider that justice and fair play can said to be done to the SC/ST people if only the following measures are initiated by the Government of India.
- National Commission for SC & ST should be given status at par with the status of a) Election Commission / Human Rights Commission, with full financial and administrative powers / autonomy.
- b) Association of SC/ST employees having majority followed in each Department / Public Sector Undertakings / Banks etc., should be recognised at par with the Trade Unions.
- c) Reservation should be extended to all Private and Multinational Companies / Banks / Institutions / Organisations.
- d) Adequate representation to be provided for SC, ST and OBC in judiciary.
- Reservation should be provided to office bearers of the Trade Unions also and that e) Workmen / Officers / Directors on the PSUs / Banks should be appointed by rotation by following roster system.
- f) SC & ST Employees Associations / Organisations should be allowed to raise the matters in the Labour Courts and Tribunals.
- g) Constitute a special bench of 5 judges in Supreme Court representing one judge each from SC, ST, OBC, Minorities and general communities, to deliver speedy and impartial judgement relating to SC and ST in general and reservation matter in particular.
- h) RESERVATION FOR SC / ST IN RAJYA SABHA Provision to be made ensuring adequate representation of SC/ST member in the Rajya Sabha also.
