Kindly refer to the letter No.17-1/2001/PL dt 30.5.2001 of the Asst Secretary (Planning), A&N Admn forwarding therewith a copy of the draft 'Approach Paper to 10th Five Year Plan (2002-2007)' regarding submission of draft 10th Five Year Tribal Sub-Plan (2002-07) and Annual Tribal Sub-Plan (2002-03).

As you are aware that Tribal Sub-Plan, though a separate document, is prepared containing the schemes to be implemented in the tribal areas, is a part of the UT Plan as a whole. The flow of fund for Tribal area is required to be at least proportionate to tribal population in this UT. The exercise for formulation of Tribal Plan and UT plan go together. Accordingly, the draft 10th Five Year Tribal Sub-Plan (2002-07) and Annual Tribal Sub-Plan (2002-03) comprising of UT flow of funds and Special Central Assistance is required to be formulated along with the UT Plan. The guidelines issued for formulation of UT plan by the Administration without apply to the Tribal Sub-Plan as well.
