Sir / Madam,

I am directed to refer to the letter No. 14-1/2001-2002/PL dated 23/08/2001 of the Assistant Secretary (Plg.), A&N Administration regarding allotment of final outlay to different sectors and submission of the Annual Plan 2001-2002.

In this connection, it is pointed out that Tribal Sub-Plan though a separate document containing the schemes to be implemented in the tribal areas is a part of the UT plan as a whole. So, exercise for formulation of Tribal Sub-Plan and UT Plan go together. Accordingly, the Annual Tribal Sub-Plan 2001-2002 comprising of UT flow of funds and SCA is required to be formulated alongwith the UT plan.

The general guidelines issued by the Special Secretary (plg.), A&N Administration vide her letter referred to above are to be followed while formulating the schemes in respect of your sector(s). The draft Annual Tribal Sub-Plan 2001-2002 has already been formulated, but it is to be recast on the basis of the final outlay allotted to your sector and commitments made to the DPC.
