



Pillobhabi	Establishment of a Vety. Sub-Centre and engaging atleast one local candidate as staff. Outside staff does not stay owing to harsh conditions	A Vety. Sub-centre was sanctioned in VIII Plan but land was provided only in 1995-96. However, CRZ clearance was required and could not be obtained. DC (C/N) agreed that space in the vacant supply godown will be provided for the sub-centre. Early steps shall be taken to open a Vety Sub-Cebntre.
Shompen Hut	Providing goats to Shompen for training in its rearing.	Already goat unit has reached to Great Nicobar. <u>It will be handed over and training will start simultaneously in consultation with local staff.</u>
	Providing backyard poultry birds to shompen	Birds have already reached Great Nicobar. The birds will be handed over soon and trailing started.
	Providing pig units on trial basis.	A trio pig unit (white Yorkshire) will be provided in April and depending upon its acceptance further steps will be taken. Otherwise, black pig from Car Nicobar will be provided later on.
Pillomillow	Opening of Vety. Sub Despensaries.	The whole area is under the jurisdiction of Vety. Hospital, Campbell Bay. The norms do not recommended for Sub-Centre, instead a camp vety sub dispensary is being considered. Already local boy was trained and engaged for 90 days at Pillomillow and Kondul. Pillopunja will also be included. These are being considered for appointment on contract basis, keeping in view the actual ground problems.
