

- (d) TUHET: Family or families including the adopted persons of a tuhet's head who inherits the tuhet's land, coconut plantations trees etc., is known as Tuhet. These tuhets in a village are the most powerful groups and they always feel proud of being the member of their village. These tuhets have social commitment with each other.
- (2) INFLUX: The Nicobarese tribal are still very simple and innocent to be easily taken adventage of by the non-tribals whose main aim is to de-stabilise the future of the Tribal for their own selfish motto. Effective steps should be taken to curb the inflow of these non-tribal into the tribal area atleast until such time the tribals are educated enough to know what is good and what is bad for them.
- NICOBARESE SETTLER AT HUT BAY (LITTLE ANDAMAN): With the oral instructions of the Chief Commissioner of Andaman & Nicobar Islands Shri. Harmender Singh, about 65 families were sent from Carnicobar in 1972 to settle down in Little Andaman at their own cost. By now the size of these families can well be imagine. So far these families have not been formally allotted their entitlement of land as per the guide line of the Administration in regard to the allotment of land to the other settlers.
- (4) MEDICAL: One of the main wings for development is the medical department. Staff's are not sufficient as per the requirements of the Civil Hospital in Carnicobar. Equipments are inadequate resulting in referring of a patient to Port Blair, quite often either by courrier service or by ship involving lots of expenditure by the poor family of the patient.
- (5) EDUCATION: The over all performance of this department is comparatively poor in the Tribal District of the Nicobars. Necessary steps to be taken so that, the standard of education in these area is raise to a satisfactory level. There may be various reasons for this which need to be found and rectified.
- (6) I.A.C. FLIGHT: Earlier we used to get one flight a week which have now been stoped due to reasons best known to the concerned authority general public's hardship could be reducted to certain extend if the IAC flight service to this Island is resumed.
