Sub: Examination of Implication of Panchayat (Extension of Scheduled Areas) Act 1996.

Sir,

Please refer to the note dated 9.7.97 regarding the subject mentioned above. On examination of the Panchayat (Extension of Scheduled Areas) Act 1996, it is found that the provisions of the gaid Act would not be prina-facie applicable to Andaman & Nicopar Islands since this Union Territory / part thereof has not been included in the Scheduled Areas as contained in the Part 9 of the Constitution of India.

However, a Tribal Council Regulation for Nicobars has been drafted and sent to the Deputy Commissioners, Nicobars, to obtain the views of the Tribal people. As per the report of the DC, Nicobars the tribal people have not yet firmed up their views on the draft Regulation.
