Chaudhary formerly Fortress Commander and subsequent reminders dated 15.6.92 and 3.8.92 on the subject mentioned above and to forward herewith a copy of telegram No. 1018 dated 24th October, 1992 from Delhi, New Delhi addressed to the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands wherein the decision of the Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence has been communicated that the Navy will retain 192 acres of land only and transfer the balance of 310 acres of remaining land at Hut Bay, Little Andaman to this Administration after due demarcation of the retainable area and observing all other necessary formalities.

I am, therefore, request you to kindly arrange handing over of 310 acres of land out of 410 acres allotted to the Navy at Hut Bay to the local Revenue authorities after due demarcation.
