OTHER HAND, THE NEW DRAFT REGULATION IS CERTAINLY INFUSE THE SYSTEM OF DEMOCRACY THROUGH VOTE POWER AND LEADERSHIP WOULD NATURALLY ABHOR THE IDEA OF SUCH DEMOCRACY FEAR OF LOOSING THEIR TRADITIONAL POWER AND INFLUENCE OVER THEIR SOCIETY (.) HOWEVER IT IS HIGH TIME THAT A TRANSPARENT DEMOCRATIC SYSTEM IS BROUGHT INTO FORCE IN THE TRIBAL AREA WHEREIN ORDINARY TRIBAL GETS FULL SCOPE FOR HIS DEVELOPMENT AND YOUNG LEADERS COME THE FORE TO DECIDE THEIR DESTINY INSTEAD OF HIGHLY CONSERVATIVE AND REGRESSIVE CAPTAINS (.) IT IS CLAIMED RY TRIBALS CAPTAINS THAT THEY HAVE A SYSTEM OF ELECTION FOR CAPTAINS (.) SUCH SYSTEM PRESENTLY LACKS THE TRANSPARENCY AND FREEDOM CONTEST THE ELECTION DUE TO SOCIAL INERTIAL PRESSURE, (.) THERE IS NO CONVASSING (.) AS A RESULT EXCEPT IN A VERY RARE CASE, SET OF PEOPLE REMAIN CAPTAINS OVER THE YEARS (.)
