Brief note on additional land for the alletment to the Nicobarase tribals of Harminder Bay, Little Andaman Island.

The Andaman & Nicebar Administration had formulated a scheme to settle 300 Nicebari families from the Car Nicebar Island to reduce the population pressure pressure on this small Island. These 300 families were to be settled in Little Andaman Island in the Andaman District. Each family under the scheme was get 10 acres of land for the horticultural activities i.e.

Accordingly, a proposal was sent to the Govt. of India for the dereservation of 3000 acres of forest land in the Little Andaman Island in 1973. The Govt, of India agreed for the release of 500 acres of forest land in Little Andaman Island, and as such during the Ath Five Year Plan 50 Nicobari families were brought and settled in a village new known as Harminder Bay in Little Andaman Island.

families were to be brought to Little Andaman Island for the settlement. Son a proposal was sent for the maximum release of yet another 500 acres of forest land. However, the Govt. of India did not agree for the dereservation of forest land any further.

In the meantime 115 Nicebari families migrates from Car Nicebar to Little Andaman Island voluntarily and started living alongwith the efficially settled 50 families who are living at Harminider Bay.

In the wake of denial of dereservation of the forest land, an exercise was made to reduce the total requirement of the land. It was decided that 400 acres of forest land could be obtained for the benefit of 165 Nicebari families in the following manner:

(1) 5 acres per family (165 X 5 = 625 acres)
(11) 75 acres of land for the community purpose.

equal area of revenue land is required to be surrendered for afforestation, but as noted by the reputy Commissions andamans there is no revenue land available for this purpose.
