8. Village Committee fund	<p>(1) The Village Committee shall establish and maintain fund to be called "<u>Village Committee Fund</u>" and there shall be placed to the credit thereof;</p> <p>(a) Such contribution from the District Council as may be made to this fund.</p> <p>(b) Such contribution from the State Government</p> <p>(c) Contribution from Corporation, Socials, Companies or other public bodies; and</p> <p>(d) Contribution from other sources.</p> <p>(2) The District Council may place at the disposal of the Village Committee the following sources of revenue accruing within the area;</p> <p>(a) Cattle pound.</p> <p>(b) Local rates.</p> <p>(c) Cart, cycles, boats and other means of conveyance but shall not include taxes on mechanically propelled vehicles;</p> <p>(d) Any other sources of revenue which may be assigned to the Village Committee.</p> <p>(3) All money received by the Village Committee in accordance with releases may be prescribed by the District Council under this Act shall be credited to the Village Committee Fund.</p>
9. Administration of Village Committee fund.	The Executive Committee at the District Council may frame rules for the management and control of the Village Committee fund and such rules may prescribe the procedure to be followed in respect of payment of money into this fund, the withdrawal thereof, its custody and any other matter connected with or ancillary to it.
10. Budget of the Village Committee	The Village Committee shall annually before end of the financial year prepare a budget and submit the same to the Executive Committee of the District Council for <u>consolation</u> and approval through such authority as may be prescribed. <i>consolidation</i>
11. Accounts	Every Village Committee shall keep accounts of its income and expenditure in such manner and in such form as may be prescribed.
12. Audit of the Account Village Committee	The Account of the Village Committee shall be subject to audit, as and when considered necessary by the Executive Committee of the District Council.
