



NICOBARI TRIBAL AREAS AUTONOMOUS DISTRICT COUNCIL ACT

- The Nicobari Tribal Areas Autonomous District Council (NTAADC) act will extend to the tribal areas of Nicobars.
- The Council shall be a body corporate by name of the "the District Council" and shall have perpetual succession and a common shall with power to acquire whole and dispose of property and may by the said name sue and sued.
- 3. The Council shall consist of 18 members who shall be elected on the basis of adult suffrage.
 - Each Island will elect one member to the Council. The Island more than thousand population will elect one additional member.
 - ii) Only a voter of the area shall be qualified as candidate.
 - iii) The Lok Sabha electoral roll will work as electoral roll for the Council.
 - The Election of the members of the District Council shall be held in accordance with the rules made under Section 6 by notification in the official gazette.
- The term of the Council will be 5 years, unless the Council is sooner dissolved under Section of this act.
- The Central Government may make rules regulating the election process as defined by the Election Commissioner of India.
- 7. The District Council shall, as soon as may be, choose in the manner described two members to be respectively the Chairman and Vice-Chairman thereof and, so often as the office of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman becomes vacant, the Council shall choose another member to be Chairman and Vice-Chairman as the case may be.
 - i) The Chairman or the Vice-Chairman of the Council shall vacate his office if he (a) seizes to be a member of the Council (b) resigns from his office (c) is removed from his office by a resolution of the Council.
- 8. There shall be an Executive Committee of the District Council consisting of 9 Executive Members including the Chairman, who shall be the head of the Executive Committee.
- 9. The executive function of the District Council shall vest in the Executive Committee.
 - 10. Each member of the Executive Committee shall be entrusted with specific subject.
 - i) one of the member of the Executive Committee will be incharge of the District Fund who shall be responsible for the budgeting and the "Ways and Means" position of the District Fund.
 - There shall be a Chief Executive Officer in the District Council who shall be appointed by the UT Government and shall be paid out of the District Fund. Such salary and allowances as may from time to time be fixed by the Administration. The Chief Executive Officer shall be incharge of the Council and shall have the right of being present in the meetings of the District Council with having authority to vote.
