- Repairs/renovation of old quarters, class rooms, toilets etc (ii)
- Supply of treated drinking water (111)
- Posting of teachers mainly Science and Maths (iv)
- Special coaching mainly on Science, Maths & English (v)
- Opening of Science medium school at Katchal to cover entire (vi) Nancowry group of islands

Suggestion

- Regular inspection by higher authorities including Director & Secretary (vii) (Education).
- Special Monitoring Cell for meritorious tribal student. Quota of 25 (viii) students to be deputed to Port Blair every year should be allocated to
- Posting of non-tribal teachers mainly on Hindi subject A huge number (ix) of students cannot read and write Hindi or even to talk in Hindi.
- Hard area allowance should be sanctioned to teachers and period of posting should be fixed

Health - posting of Doctors and other Para medical staff etc Point-05

Background:

- In a number of villagers, the existing Sub centers is very very far off.
- In absence of regular boat services, Doctors do n't visit the Sub centers (ii) in the remote islands -Nancowry group of islands, Little Nicobar, Great
- Posting of ANM/Pharmacist not adequate in Sub centers (iii)
- Quarters for staff not adequate. Even in some of the islands there is no (iv)
- Shortage of quarter is acute (v)
- A number of T.B patient (Katchal Island) admitted with general patients (vi)
- Ambulance/Maruti Van provided not sufficient to cover the islands (vii)
- Demand of Family Planning, but shortage of Gynecologist (viii)
- CHC Kamorta neither posted nor regular visit by Specialist. (ix)
- Visit of Higher authorities is not regular (x)
- Maximum who are contract Doctors (new hands) posted (xi)
- Construction of road/regular ferry service required to attend the (i) patients to the Sub centers
- Ensures regular boat service with Doctors to visit once in week to (ii) Nancowry group of islands, Little Nicobar and Great Nicobar tribal region with Pathology and others team
- Posting of Pharmacist and ANM to Sub centers

Suggestion

- (iii) Opening more Sub centers - Ayurvedic (Tribals are fond of herbal (iv) medicine), Homeopathic and Allopathic within easily reachable place.
- Construction of new quarters and repairs/renovation of old quarters
- (v) Among tribal, a good number is TB patient. A TB Ward should be (vi) constructed at Katchal PHC and special package in a form of Ship fare to encourage so that such patients are admitted in GB Pant TB Ward for treatment till his full recovery. During the period of his stay at Hospital, a minimum amount of Rs. 70/- per day should be paid to the patient for maintaining his family.
- Provide Tata/Mahindra Type Ambulance in place of Maruti Van (vii)
- Doctors posted at PHC should trained in family planning operation (viii) with supporting staff
- Ensure regular visit of Specialist atleast twice in a month in Kamorta (ix) and Campbell Bay Hospital. Visit of senior officials.
