Out of 26, 6 villages are going to be covered by Inmarsat by 31.01.2003 and 6 more are proposed for Inmarsat. Rest 14 are scattered in the Islands, where Telephone Exchanges are available and will be covered by Land Line.

In addition 40 more remote villages / places have been provided with Telephone facilities.

MARR not working.

One external agency has been engaged for maintenance of MARR, who attends the fault in case of faults and also is monitored by Officer / Staff.

Telephone services from one tribal island to other Islands lines are not available.
