This is a good suggestion. To impart training programmes on new methodologies of cultivation, un employed youth among tribal population will be invited for training.

**(ii) Benefits of the Scheme from reach to un reach:-**

For the welfare of tribal population in addition to the Tribal Sub-Plan, the following five schemes of Special Central Assistance schemes are also being implemented by this department for Primitive tribes of Strait Island, Little Andaman, Terressa and Camp Bell bay.viz.

1.	Raising and maintenance of Plantation at Great Nicobar for the benefit of Shompens and Nicobaries.
2.	Raising and maintenance of Plantation and vegetable garden at Little Andaman for the benefit of Ongese and Nicobaries.
3.	Raising and maintenance of Plantation and vegetable garden at Strait Island for the benefit of Great Andamanese.
4.	Utilization of degraded land for raising cashew, fruits, spices, arecanut etc. in Teressa Islands.
5.	Raising of scattered plantation in South Andaman for the benefit of Jarawas.

For implementing of the SCA Schemes, Grant in Aid is being received from the Tribal Welfare Department of A & N Islands.

**FISHERIES**

**i) Most of the islands have no Sub centres**

The Fisheries Dept. have a Zonal fisheries office at Car Nicobar with jurisdiction through out the tribal dist. Of Nicobar under this Zonal Fisheries Office 3 Fisheries Sub-Station are functioning one each at Katchal, Nancowry and Campbell Bay.

**ii) The benefits of the above departments have not reached to the tribal.**

All the remote and isolated islands in Nicobar dist. Comes under the jurisdiction of the 4 offices mentioned above However having felt the need to give better coverage & requirements of tribes living in remote islands, the jurisdiction of the Fisheries Sub-Station have been revised.
