your Administration's am directed to refer letter No. 7-44/98-Legal dated 12th August, 1999 on the subject mentioned above and to say that the aforesaid Regulation provides for protection of interests of socially and economically backward Aborigional Tribes Andaman and Nicobar Islands. VIt is proposed that the penal provision of fine up to Rs. 1000/- which was fixed way back in 1956 is no longer sufficient and the same Amay be enhanced to Rs. 2000/- and the minimum period of imprisonment may be extended from one year to two years. The matter has been examined in consultation with the Ministry of Law, Justice and Company Affairs who have observed that such a minimum period of imprisonment is normally provided in the law aimed at removing social evils such as in dowry prohibition or in law aimed at protecting society from danger of Narcotics Drugs and the proposed psychotropic substances. Secondly, two years will make the offence cognizable

In view of the above, you are requested reconsider the aforesaid proposal in the light of the connected consequences and ensure that it meets your Please also send a statement indicating the intentions. during the last ten years; cases booked punishment awarded year-wise.
