THE ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS (PROTECTION
OF ABORIGINAL TRIBES) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATION, 1998.

Promulgated by the President in the Forty ninth year of the Republic of India.

A Regulation further to amend the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Regulation, 1956.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 240 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to promulgate the following regulation made by him :-

Short title
and commence-
ment.

- 1) 1) This Regulation may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) (Amendment) Regulation, 1998.
1i) It shall come into force on such date as the Lieutenant Governor may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

- 2) In the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Regulation, 1956 (here-in-after referred to as " the Principal Regulation"), the word ' Chief Commissioner ' wherever it appears may be read as " LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR".

Amendment of
Section 2(b).

- 3) In the Principal Regulation instead of the definition of the word 'Chief Commissioner' in Section 2(b), the following may be substituted:-

" (b) " Lieutenant Governor" means the Lieutenant Governor of the Union Territory of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands appointed under article 239 of the Constitution".

Amendment of
Section '8'

- 4) ✓ In the Principal Regulation instead of the existing provisions under the Sub-Sections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 8, the following shall be substituted:-
