1955.A&N Islands Live Stock Improvement Regulation.

The amendments suggested were thoroughly discussed and agreed to as follows:-

(1) Under this regulations the powers or duties of enforcing this regulation is conferred on the Livestock Officer. At present the post of Livestock Officer in this Department is not in existence. This requires to be modified as Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services.

(2) As per, Class III of this regulation the Chief Commissioner is empowered by a general order or a special order to impose the powers or duties of Livestock Officer on any person. This requires amendment, because as per the provision of the Indian Veterinary Council Act 1984 these duties can be entrusted only to a registered Veterinary practitioner.

(3) The penalties provided for under the regulation for contravention of the provision contained in the regulation is given as punishable with fine of Rs.50/- and in case of second and subsequent offence with fine which may extend to Rs.100/-. The amount prescribed as fine under the regulation needs to be enhanced so as to serve as effective deterrent to the offenders.
