

INFLUX OF NON-TRIBALS IN TRIBAL AREAS

I. BACKGROUND:

Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Regulation, 1956 was promulgated to provide for protection of the interests of socially and economically backward aboriginal tribes in the Andaman and Nicobar islands. The entire area comprising in, and enclosed within the coast line of each of the following islands but excluding the area comprising the air-field in Car Nicobar and ports of Kamorta and Car Nicobar was declared to be reserved area vide Notification No.3 dated 2nd April, 1957 namely:-
