

- (x) Labourers should be authorised to stay in designated area on
- (xi) An undertaking should be obtained from contractor regarding repatriation of labour on expiry of contract or six months whichever is earlier.

### C. CONDITIONS FOR OBTAINING TRADE LICENCE (SHOPS, BUSINESS)

- (i) All business establishments/shops run by non-tribals & the name of tribals should be registered.
- (ii) No non-tribal should be allowed to stay in the area for more than one year. Police authorities may be authorised to deport/repatriate labour immediately after the expiry of pass.
- (iii) All licenses like fishing, stevedoring and other minor works should be issued only after verifying Trade license issued by D C(N).

## 2. STRENGTHENING OF EXISTING INFRASTRUCTURE.

### A. STRENGTHENING OF ADMINISTRATIVE INFRASTRUCTURE.

- (i) Appointment of 12 Nos. of Tribal Welfare Officers (TWOs) for all the inhabited islands with magisterial powers. Officials of other departments in these islands can be given the responsibility of checking influx till the appointment of TWOs. These officials should be made responsible for preventing entry of unauthorised persons in these islands.
- (ii) Sensitisation of government servants to the special provisions of PAT, 1956 by imparting training.
- (iii) Creation of special task force headed by Supdt. of Police placed under D C(N) exclusively for the purpose of checking influx.
