## THE ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS (PROTECTION OF ABORIGINAL TRIBES)(AMENDMENT) REGULATION, 2002.

Promulgated by the President in the Forty ninth year of the Republic of India.

A Regulation further to amend the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Regulation, 1956.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 240 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to promulgate the following regulation made by him:-

- This Regulation may be called the Andaman & Nicobar Islands and (Protection of Aboriginal -Tribes) (Amendment) Regulation, 2002.
- ii) It shall come into force on such date as the Lieutenant Governor may by Notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

Amendment of Section '8'

In the Principal Regulation, instead of the existing provisions under the sub-sections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 8, the following shall be substituted:

- 1) Whoever, in contravention of the provision of Section 6 acquires any interest in or in any product of or crop raised on any land or carries on any trade or business, in the reserved area, shall be punishable with imprisonment which may extend to one year and fine which may extend to Rs.10,000/- and the interest so acquired shall be disposed of in such manner as the Lieutenant Governor may, after taking into consideration the circumstances of the case, direct.
- 2) Whoever in contravention of a Notification issued under Section 7 enters a reserved area shall be punishable with imprisonment which may extend to one year and fine which may extend to Rs. 10,000/-.
- 3) Whoever, does anything in contravention of any of the conditions or restrictions subject to which a pass has been granted to him under section 7, shall be punishable with imprisonment which may extend to one year and fine which may extend to Rs. 10,000/-.
